## Organ Music Today

**Organ Prelude: J. S Bach (1685-1750): fragments from Organ Partita Sei gegrüßet, Jesu, gütig" (Hail to you, kind Jesus), BWV 768**

**Organ Postlude: J. S. Bach (1685-1750) - Fugue F Major, BWV 540.**

The Fugue is filled with chromaticism and dissonances and has 2 themes which are exposed in separate sections and then combined in a moment of contrapuntal majesty. It is the only throughout double fugue that Bach ever composed. The first subject uses slow and deliberate whole and half notes as if they were rudimentary building blocks resulting in a chorale-like texture of a rare noble beauty, and a second subject using livelier, smaller division notes, almost dance like.

Listen for the moment in the final bars when the opening falling chromatic fugue subject enters in the mighty bass line of the pedals and the 2 themes now used simultaneously. Bach's subject is a persistent, unrelenting Power which cannot be ignored leading to a majestic and inspiring, yet full of warmth finale.
