Responsive Reading

Based on Luke 4, Isaiah 58, 61, 1 John 4

- LEADER *When he came to the town of Nazareth, his boyhood home, he went as usual to the synagogue on the Sabbath and stood to read the scriptures. The scroll of the prophet Isaiah was given to him. He unrolled the scroll and found the place where this is written:*
- CONGREGATION **The Spirit of the Lord is upon me,
For he has anointed me to bring good news to the poor.
He has sent me to proclaim liberty to the captives,
restoration of sight to the blind,
to set free the oppressed,
And to proclaim the time of the Lord's favor.**
- LEADER *He rolled up the scroll, handed it back to the attendant, and sat down. All eyes in the synagogue looked at him intently. Then, he began to speak to them, saying,*
- CONGREGATION **"The Scripture you've just heard has been fulfilled this very day!"**
- LEADER *This is how God showed His love among us:*
- CONGREGATION **This is love: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.**
- LEADER *Dear Friends, since God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. How can we do this? Free those who are wrongly imprisoned; lighten the burden of those who work for you.*
- CONGREGATION **Let the oppressed go free and remove the chains that bind people.**
- LEADER *Share your food with the hungry and give shelter to the homeless.*
- CONGREGATION **Give clothes to those who need them, and do not hide from your relatives that need help.**
- LEADER *Remove the yoke of oppression. Stop pointing your finger and speaking wickedness.*
- CONGREGATION **Satisfy the needs of the oppressed and you will be like a watered garden.**
- LEADER *Honor God during the Sabbath day in everything you do.*
- CONGREGATION **Enjoy the Sabbath and speak of it with delight as the Lord's holy day.**
- LEADER *Then your light will shine forth from the darkness, and the darkness around you will be as bright as noon. The Lord will guide you always; He will satisfy your needs, and you will find joy in the Lord.*
- CONGREGATION **If we love one another, God is living in us, and His love is made complete in us.**

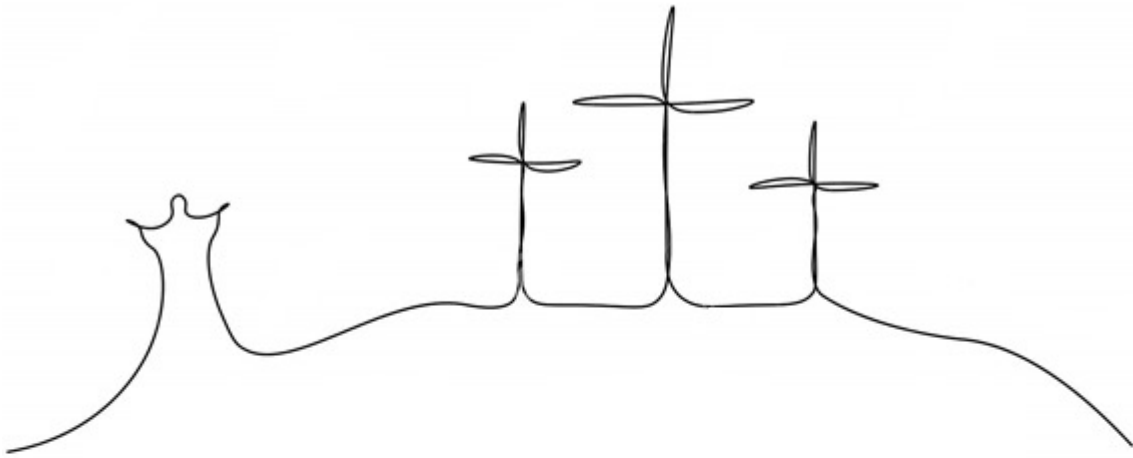

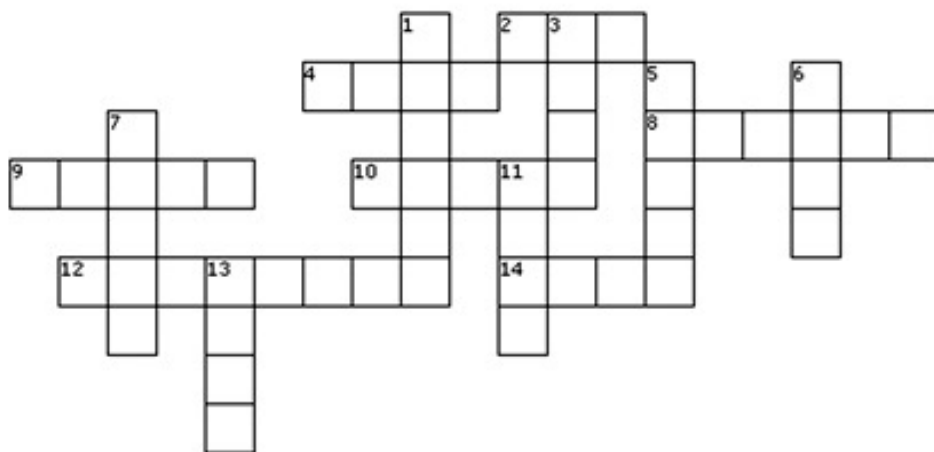
