In his Choral No. 1 in E major, Cesar Franck invites a patient observer to discern and discover relationships between motives in a form which is basically a theme followed by three variations. At the same time, the alternation between manuals, suggests not only antiphonal use of the instrument, but symbolism assigned to each manual as well.

The Prelude and Fugue in A minor, BWV 543, dating from the later Weimar years (1716/17), shows how confidently Bach has built on the typical devices of Buxtehude, pacing the movement to ensure forward momentum and tightening the progression of the rich harmony.
