"Following the pivotal Minneapolis General Conference of 1888, Ellen White and A.T.Jones presented a week of prayer at Atlantic Union College (then SLA), that resulted in a revival that matched any in Adventist history. A Sunday law was before the US Senate, and God was moving to pour out the Holy Spirit in latter rain power. "Every youth" was converted. Ministers were led to repentance and revival. We are now approaching another pivotal time in the history of one of God's institutions at AUC. Presentation with Q&A by Pastor Bill Brace and Dr. Bob Hunsaker.
