

Organ Prelude: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750): Fantasia in C Minor for organ, BWV 537 Organ Postlude: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750): Fugue in C Minor for organ, BWV 537

It is January, 10th, 1751, and two musicians, father and son, have just taken time to copy out a manuscript of an organ piece composed by their organ and composition teacher. It is shortly after Bach's death and the musicians are Tobias and Ludwig Krebs. Ludwig, the son of Tobias was considered by Bach the most gifted among his students. This was going to be the only surviving copy of Fantasia and Fugue in C Minor, BWV 537, the piece we will be hearing today. Without their dedication, this extraordinary piece would have been forever lost to posterity.

The somber Fantasia is based on two pedal points and the imitative treatment of a lament motive, almost identical to the aria from St Matthew's Passion where Peter weeps bitterly after just having betrayed his Saviour. The Fantasia concludes in an open-ended fashion on a half cadence, forming an organic bridge to the Fugue. With the Fugue, Bach takes a lyrical form and uses it as a vessel for contrapuntal development with two subjects, A and B. He focuses on the contrasting nature of the two themes and their differing treatment. Perhaps nowhere is his writing more concise, direct, and intense than in the Fugue of the Fantasia and Fugue in C Minor.
