# *Welcome To* Stoneham Memorial Church

#### Organ Prelude and Postlude: J. S. Bach: Praeludium in E-flat Major for organ, BWV 552

The Prelude and fugue are seen as a deliberate representation of the three figures of the Trinity. In the Prelude, first of all, God the Father is represented with majestic chords, in the style of a French Overture (the 'royal' music of the time) and imposing motifs. Then comes "Christ who is the image of God, the only begotten of the Father; he descends to become man and to save through suffering." To depict this, Bach is using a rather 'fluid' style, full of variation, accents, and motifs symbolizing descending from above and pain. And finally, after a 'Father recapitulation', the Holy Spirit descends to fast notes in a three-part double fugue, like a rushing wind, fiery tongues, and the dove linked through rhythmic figures . Bach borrows from the French, Italian and German composition styles, respectively – in his own unique way, of course.

Although identifying the musical motives might be important and rewarding, the description above is just a general presentation of a very complex music. By playing this Praeludium twice (at the beginning and the end of the service), I would like it to provide a musical background to Isaiah vision in Ch. 6: "I saw also the Lord sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple. Above it stood the seraphims: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly. And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the Lord of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory. And the posts of the door moved at the voice of him that cried, and the house was filled with smoke." What a privilege is to be children of such an omnipotent God, who loves us and wants us with him for eternity.
