

Organ Prelude: J. S. Bach (1685-1750): Organ Chorales BWV 672-674 Organ Postlude: J. S. Bach (1685-1750): Organ Chorale BWV 680

The prelude consists of three pieces, which are smaller counterparts to the great organ chorales with the same titles are composed around the long melodies of a 'trope': a standard hymn with extra texts. Each piece is devoted to one facet of the Trinity, whereby Bach gives a symbolic place to the cantus firmus (the existing melody): first to God the Father, then to God the Son, and finally to God the Holy Ghost.

The Chorale on "We Believe in One God" is both exuberant and triumphal. Bach ignored the long chorale melody for the larger part. Luther's melody first line, to which the words 'we believe in one God' are sung, were more than enough for him. He formed it into a jubilant theme, in which a buoyant downward leap generates a festive string of semiquavers. The material forms the basis for a spirited fugue that assures the listener that only one thing matters: faith.
