

Organ Prelude: Johann Sebastian Bach: "Our Father who Art in Heaven" BWV 682 Organ Prelude: Johann Sebastian Bach: "Our Father who Art in Heaven" BWV 682

In this setting of the 'Lord's Prayer' the two melodic voices and bass part actually create the form of a trio sonata. The original song melody is highly embellished. Here the music emphasizes the concepts of suffering, guilt, patience and obedience. This piece has long been considered the most complex of Bach's chorale preludes, difficult at the levels of both understanding and performance.

The Prelude in E-flat Major is seen as a deliberate representation of the three figures of the Trinity. In the Prelude, first of all, God the Father is represented with majestic chords, in the musical style of a French Ouverture (the 'royal' music of the time) and imposing motifs. Then comes "Christ who is the image of God, the only begotten of the Father; he descends to become man and to save through suffering." To depict this, Bach is using a rather 'fluid' style, full of variation, accents, and motifs symbolizing descending from above and pain. And finally, after a 'Father recapitulation', the Holy Spirit descends to fast notes like a rushing wind, fiery tongues, and the dove linked through rhythmic figures. ed
