

Organ Prelude: J. S. Bach (1685-1750): 'These are the ten holy commandments' BWV 677 Organ Postlude: J. S. Bach (1685-1750): Fugue in C Minor, BWV 537

Choral prelude BWV 677 belongs to a group of chorales set by Bach on texts by Luther. Here he sets the tune in canon on a separate manual. This has particular significance for a hymn about the ten commandments, since the word "canon" literally means "rule" or "law." The second canonic voice follows the first by a strict rule of counterpoint. There is a reference to the number ten in the first measure, where each of the three voices forms the interval of a tenth with the other two.

With the C-Minor fugue, Bach takes a lyrical form and uses it as a vessel for contrapuntal development with two subjects, A and B. The subjects of the A and B sections are never combined; Bach focuses instead on the contrasting nature of the two themes and their differing contrapuntal treatment. Perhaps nowhere is his writing more concise, direct, and intense than in this piece.
