Organ Prelude: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750) - Praeludium in C Minor BWV 546 Organ Postlude: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750) - Fugue in C Minor BWV 546

The Prelude, which is a substantial piece with a somber and majestic affect, begins with a series of antiphonal chords written in a manner reminiscent of the polychoral style of Giovanni Gabrieli. This material returns throughout the prelude. The prelude concludes as though reminding the player and listener alike that "the light shines in the darkness and the darkness does not overcome it."

The Fugue, which might have been composed earlier than the Prelude, uses an initial slower movement which gives way to flowing waves that soon dominate, with the final bars reaching the heights of intensity and expression found in the Prelude.
