

Prelude: J. S Bach (1685-1750): Fantasia in c-Minor, BWV 562 for organ

Postlude: Max Reger (1873-1916): Chorale Fantasia on 'A Mighty Fortress is Our God' op 27

The C minor Fantasia BWV 562 is surely one of Bach's greatest Fantasias, grand in scope and very powerful in affect. It engenders a great feel of yearning from the initial descending phrase, and from the harmonies and suspensions that are effortlessly created by a complex counterpoint.

To commemorate Reformation Day (Oct, 31st), we will hear a fragment from the first important composition of Max Reger, fantasia on Martin Luther's choral 'A Mighty Fortress is Our God'. He composed this music in 1898, following the model of setting individual stanzas, connected by interludes setting the mood.
