Organ Prelude: J.S. Bach (1685-1750): 'Now thank we all our God' BWV 657 Organ Prelude: J.S. Bach (1685-1750): 'Now thank we all our God' from Cantata BWV 79

The joy and the faith in God expressed in the text of this hymn are interpreted in multiple motifs. Sometimes, Bach lets the parts speak out, and then they tumble over one another again, adding to the lively character. Bach lends extra harmonic tension to the introduction to the seventh entrance, before letting the closing phrase culminate in a long pedal point above a melodic explosion in the alto and tenor. What a wonderfully inspired piece of music!

As Postlude we will hear a rousing organ solo arrangement by the great American organist Virgil Fox (1912-1980) of the third movement from Bach's Leipzig Cantata 79.
