# Welcome To Stoneham Memorial Church

Organ Prelude: J. S Bach (1685-1750): Fantasia in c-Minor, BWV 562 for organ  
Organ Postlude: J. S Bach (1685-1750): Fantasia and Fugue in c-Minor, BWV 562 for organ  
The C minor Fantasia BWV 562 is surely one of Bach's greatest Fantasias, grand in scope and very powerful in affect. It engenders a great feel of yearning from the initial descending phrase, and from the harmonies and suspensions that are effortlessly created by a complex counterpoint.

Here Bach took inspiration from the French composer Nicolas de Grigny (1672-1703) whose 'Organ Book' he had earlier copied by hand. However, by using his contrapuntal skills Bach created a piece based on a simple, descending theme which keeps presenting itself from the beginning to the very end. A few years later, he attached a fugue to this Fantasia, which was left unfinished, so the music will be abruptly ending where the author stopped.
