Organ Postlude: J. S. Bach (1685-1750): Toccata in C Major BWV 564

Weihnachten (Christmas) for Reger is not a happy succession of joyous noels; it is definitely the first world war Christmas-mood, the gloom of which is partially dispelled by a tour de force of poetry and a genial combination of the melodies of "From Heaven Above" and of the immortal "Holy Night," upon which it closes.

The Bach Toccata opens with a manual solo followed by perhaps the longest pedal solo in all organ literature. Both are equally amazing and use all the registers of the organ. Using musical rhetoric Bach tries to impress upon us the joy of worshipping God and his creation. But it does not end here. After many fireworks, the movement races on with two infectious dialoguing themes, while towards the end, Bach revisits all the octaves, this time in a minor key.
