Organ Prelude: J. S. Bach (1685-1750): Choral 'Saviour of the Nations Come' BWV 659 Organ Postlude: J. S. Bach (1685-1750) Fugue in C-Major, BWV 564

The organ choral on 'Saviour of the Nations Come' captures the world's amazement as though everyone is holding their breath (musically reinforced by a harmonic pause and an abrupt slowing of the bass) – a technique often used by Bach when writing about the birth of Jesus. It makes this piece one of the most effective depictions of Saviour's first coming.

The exuberant fugue completes the Toccata and Adagio of BWV 564 and is remarkable for its length and for the light-hearted combination of a exuberant theme and a flowing counter-theme that fills in the silence which is quite unique for Bach. There is no manuscript source, so we will never know whether Bach actually intended the final chord to be so brief and the pedal to fall silent a couple of bars before the end. However, this brings the music to a rather abrupt and quiet ending.
