

Organ Prelude: J. S. Bach (1685-1750): Fantasia & Imitatio in B Minor, BWV 563 Organ Postlude: J. S. Bach (1685-1750): Fantasia & Imitatio in B Minor, BWV 563

The Fantasia is written for manuals only, building the whole piece out of light figures, in four-parts. The work reflects careful craftsmanship. The connection between Imitatio and Fantasia, is seen in the shared manual texture, and a certain symmetry in the shape of the opening motifs. The chief difference lies in the metre of the Imitatio - quadruple (4/4) becomes a dancing triple (3/4).
