Prelude: Theodore Dubois (1837-1924): 'In Paradisum' (#9 from '12 Pieces for Organ)

Postlude: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750): Fugue in C Major, BWV 545

Theodore Dubois imagined the Paradise in ethereal and serene colors, with a delicate chant accompanied on the flute registers by the slow and undulating movement of angels' wings. Dubois, an exceptional musician who was the organist of Madeleine church in Paris and director of the Paris Conservatory dreamed of being celebrated for opera music but is mostly remembered for his numerous religious compositions.

The fugue in C Major, BWV 545 builds as a grandiose, festive and imposing monument from 4 simple consecutive sounds. It is the first of the great preludes and fugues from the mature period of Bach, who described his contrapuntal compositional technique as: 'when a voice has nothing to say it has to be quiet'. As for the interpreter, he also had a simple advice: 'hit the right key with the right finger at the right moment'. What could be easier?
