Prelude: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750): "O Lamb of God, Innocent" BWV 656

Postlude: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750) – Fugue in C Minor BWV 546

"O Lamb of God, innocent" is an early [Lutheran hymn](#), with text and melody attributed to [Nikolaus Decius](#) who published it in 1522, before the first hymns of Luther. Bach's version is considered a "marvel of profoundly religious art".

The [Lamb of God](#) is called three times, twice asking for mercy, the third time for peace. The Fugue, which might have been composed earlier than the Prelude, uses an initial slower movement which gives way to flowing waves that soon dominate, with the final bars reaching the heights of intensity and expression found in the Prelude.
