Prelude: J. S. Bach - Choral Prelude: 'O Man, Bemoan thy Grievous Sin' BWV 622

Postlude: J. S. Bach - Prelude in C Minor BWV 546

Today, on our new organ we come to the most sublime of all the chorale preludes, and one of Bach's greatest pieces in any form: 'O Man Bemoan thy Grievous Sin'. The chorale text takes us away from the turmoil of the world, instead asking us to look inward and reflect on our own flaws in light of the cross and the price paid for our salvation. Bach chose the most tender of forms, an ornamented chorale, for this moment of grief-stricken introspection, and his writing is so exquisite that this piece has always held a special place among his organ works. The Prelude, which is a substantial piece with a somber and majestic affect, begins with a series of antiphonal chords written in a manner reminiscent of the polychoral style of Giovanni Gabrielli. This material returns throughout the prelude. The prelude concludes as though reminding the player and listener alike that "the light shines in the darkness and the darkness does not overcome it."
