Organ Prelude: Johannes Brahms (1833-1897) - O Sacred head now wounded, Op. 122/10 Organ Postlude: Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750) - Christ ist risen, BWV 627

In the last summer of his life, the very last pieces that Brahms ever wrote were a set of works for organ in the style of Bach. This Chorale Prelude comes from the beautiful hymn that Brahms knew from Bach's works, including St. Matthew Passion. The hymn was associated with the words "Oh sacred head, now wounded." Brahms creates a magical undulation of clever strokes in this small masterpiece while meditating on the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross. Through the three sections of 'Christ ist erstanden' Bach builds excitement gradually, by slowly extending motifs and increasing harmonic and textural intensity. The chorale is reminiscent of the slow build in intensity and excitement of the Easter story, culminating in the triumph of Easter morning, when Christ broke the bonds of death and burst forth out of the tomb. Christ is risen! Alleluia!
