J. S. Bach (1685-1750): Prelude and Fugue in E Major for Organ BWV 566

Tocatta and Fugue in E Major was written by Johann Sebastian Bach probably during his 4 month-stay at Lübeck in 1705 where he studied with Buxtehude. It's five contrasting sections show a fantastic freedom of spirit and invention and a masterful assimilation of Buxtehude's technique. This lesser known masterpiece is the 5th of toccatas and fugues that Bach wrote for organ.
