**Organ Prelude, Offertory and Postlude:** J. S. Bach: Passacaglia in c-Minor BWV 582  
How do religious composers create works that express the divine?

Bach's *Passacaglia and Fugue in C minor* is the paramount example of a divinely inspired work of music. Through its diligent use of musical language, rhythm, form, harmony, numerology, and other compositional methods, Biblical signs are woven throughout the entire piece. In 20 variations and a fugue, Bach constructs a musical narrative of the Bible's journey through the Old Testament, the birth of Jesus Christ, his Crucifixion and Resurrection.
