Nicolas de Grigny, an almost forgotten French composer and organist of genius who only lived 31 years, after summing the work of his predecessors took it to such a development that he had no immediate successor. However Bach, who never left Germany, knew about him and copied his compositions by hand for his own study in 1713.

Bach's *Passacaglia and Fugue in C minor* is speaking to us in unmistakable musical and spiritual language through its diligent use of rhythm, form, harmony, numerology, and other compositional method. Biblical signs are woven throughout the entire piece. Bach constructs a musical narrative of the Bible's journey through the Old Testament, the birth of Jesus Christ, his Crucifixion, Resurrection and his glorious return to the earth.
